SUBJECT: PLAYER ID CARDS

Good morning gentlemen,

At last Friday's meeting of the Management Committee the issue of clubs continuing to play without player ID cards was discussed at length. Please note the following policy, which is to be enforced by all referees without exception:

Commencing on Sunday 16th August 2009 every player participating in a Vicsoccer match must have an official Vicsoccer photo-ID card, which must be submitted to the referee before the match commences. Any player without an ID card is not permitted to play.

Should any club not have ID cards for their players the match is to be abandoned and a report submitted to the Vicsoccer office. Should any club attempt to field one or more players who do not have ID cards the club is to be informed that the player is not permitted to play. If the club insists on fielding the player the match is NOT TO PROCEED.

The Vicsoccer office is under strict instructions from the Management Committee that there is to be no exceptions to this policy. Therefore, if any club claims to have made such an arrangement with the office that claim is not true, and is to be ignored. Clubs have been given 2 weeks notice that this policy is to be implemented, so it's zero tolerance on ID cards as from the 16th August.

It's really quite simple - NO ID CARD - NO PLAY.
