REPLACING MISSING ID CARDS

Referees have now been asked to report any instances of clubs failing to provide an official Vicsoccer photo ID card for any player listed on the team sheet. Clubs must take whatever action is necessary to obtain or replace ID cards not in their possession. Where a driver license sized ID card has been issued to a club previously, a replacement cost of \$20 per card is applicable to cards lost by the club. If the referee took the card for a send off or other misconduct, and where that sendoff or misconduct is recorded on the club's history, and where the card was not subsequently returned to the club, a replacement card will be issued at no cost.

Each instance of a club not presenting an official ID card for each player will be investigated, and automatic penalties apply. For the first offence, clubs will be given a formal warning and thereafter the appropriate financial penalty will apply. This week each club is being sent a list of ID cards held in the office, and suitable arrangements need to be made to have the cards either collected or posted out. Posting of cards incurs a \$6 fee, as all cards are posted by Express Post, with guaranteed next day delivery.

CHECKING YOUR OPPONENTS IDs

Each club has the right to take possession of and check the ID cards of their opponents. A duly nominated club official must make the request to the referee, who will hand over the ID cards either at the beginning of the match or at half time. Here is a summary of the rules relating to checking your opponents ID cards:

1. Only a nominated club official wearing an official Vicsoccer Club Official ID may request and collect the opponent's ID cards,
2. The referee will count the cards and record the number of cards, the Club Official ID number, and the name of the club official to whom the cards are given.
3. The cards must be returned at the end of the match, and the referee will again count the cards to verify they have all been returned. The cards must be returned by the same person to whom they were initially given.
4. Failure to return all of your opponents cards to the referee immediately after the match may result in disciplinary action. If the cards are not returned for any reason, they will be reprinted and invoiced to the club that failed to return them at the current replacement card cost (currently \$20 per card)

WE'RE STILL GETTING IT WRONG

There are still some clubs using the online registration system who are not complying with the ID photo requirements relating to size, resolution and file naming protocols.

You are reminded, yet again, that photos that do not meet the requirements specified on the on-line registration page will incur a image

editing surcharged of \$5 per photo that needs to be altered.

Photos that contain spaces in the file names are not useable, and no ID cards can be produced until photos are submitted with appropriate file names.

It really isn't all that difficult. Most clubs got it right the first time.

PLAYERS EQUIPMENT

Law Four is clear in the requirements that must be met in regards to the player's equipment. Here is a brief summary.

Firstly, there is an overriding principal that player's may not wear anything that is dangerous to themselves or any other player. Specifically, this includes any kind of jewellery. All items of jewellery must be removed. This includes wedding rings, and any item that may have any religious significance. They must be removed, without exception. If they are not, or cannot be removed, then the player is not permitted to play. Referees may advise players before the match commences to remove jewellery, but they are not obliged to do so. It is the player's responsibility to know the rules. If the referee does advise players to remove jewellery prior to the match, then any player found to be in violation of that directive during the match is cautioned (yellow card) for unsporting behaviour. If the referee has not given that specific instruction, then any player seen to be wearing jewellery will be told to remove it, and will be cautioned if he is subsequently seen not to have removed it.

Players must also wear shin guards, which must offer a reasonable degree of protection. To achieve this, they must be made of a material and be of a size that satisfies the referee that reasonable protection is being provided. This is a matter of judgement for the referee, and we will always support referees in any such judgement call.
